Lea Salonga is an absolute powerhouse both on stage and screen. From her stunning portrayal of Kim in *Miss Saigon* that cemented her place in history, to her recent ventures like starring in *Here Lies Love* at the Broadway Theater, and her incredible performance in *Old Friends* alongside the iconic Bernadette Peters, she continually proves why she's a legend in the theater world.

In addition to her iconic Tony win for her role in *Miss Saigon*, she has won an Olivier, Drama Desk, Outer Critics Circle, and Theatre World Awards. She was also the first Asian to play Eponine in the musical *Les Misérables* on Broadway and returned to the beloved show as Fantine in the 2006 revival. Never one to disappoint her fans, she has made cameos in numerous movies and television specials including the breakout hit *KPop Demon Hunters* where she performs the singing voice of Celine.
