Dominating the charts upon its 1979 release, Supertramp's *Breakfast in America* soared to international acclaim with its signature blend of progressive rock sensibilities and irresistibly catchy pop hooks. In a time dominated by disco, *Breakfast in America*'s immediate chart-topping success was an unexpected surprise. Rolling Stone described the album as "a textbook-perfect album of post-Beatles, keyboard-centered English art rock that strikes the shrewdest possible balance between quasi-symphonic classicism and rock & roll" with other critics calling it "flawless," "tightly-written" and the band's "high water mark." Their winning combination of a distinct sound palette paired with infectious melodies gave us playful hits like "The Logical Song" and now iconic tracks like "Goodbye Stranger."

"Supertramp is a unique voice in the world of 70s art-rock. And within the band there are two unique voices," says Ryan Granville-Martin, Classic Albums Live singer. "I can't wait to



sing Rick Davies' parts from *Breakfast in America* at Jack Singer Concert Hall — one of my top two favourite venues in the country. Seriously!"

Classic Albums Live is a Canadian group that has helped to shape a new definition of live listening party, with performances focused on precision and authenticity, note for note, cut for cut, just as fans remember it. Werklund Centre (formerly Arts Commons) is the steward of Western Canada's largest arts centre and the artistic and civic cornerstone of Calgary's downtown core that fosters the arts through live performance, educational opportunities, and artist development. For 40 years, it has been a key contributor to the social, economic, cultural, and intellectual life and well-being of Calgarians—a commitment that is being renewed through the Werklund Centre Transformation project, the largest cultural infrastructure project in Canadian history. It is home to five resident companies, including Alberta Theatre Projects, Calgary Philharmonic Orchestra, Downstage, Theatre Calgary, and One Yellow Rabbit. It houses six gallery spaces, five theatres, a concert hall, rehearsal and education spaces, costume and scene shops, and a restaurant.
